The Department of Allergy and Clinical Immunology is located at the Johns Hopkins Center for Asthma and Allergy, near Hopkins Bayview Medical Center. Bayview Medical Center, formerly Baltimore City Hospital and then Francis Scott Key Hospital, was a major training center for medical school students and home staff for years and became wholly owned by Johns Hopkins in 1985. The 130,000-square-foot Asthma and Allergy Center facility, which opened in 1989, also includes the Division of Pulmonary and Critical Medicine Medical Institutions, as well as the Department of Rheumatology at the Vasculitis Center. These three departments operate outpatient clinics along with clinical trials, bringing these interventions in the same building as laboratory tests. Some clinical and research activities on the curriculum are conducted in other parts of the university and at Johns Hopkins Hospital. The Department of Pediatrics conducts three semi-annual clinic sessions dedicated to children's allergies and one session to assess the state of immunodeficiency. These clinics provide an excellent learning environment for fellows in allergy and clinical immunology. Consultation services in Allergy and Clinical Immunology are provided for inpatients at both Johns Hopkins Hospital and Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center. Elective time in allied clinical specialties can also be arranged if desired. Pulmonary medicine, rheumatology and immunological dermatology are frequent choices. Training in otolaryngology, general dermatology and immunodeficiency can also be provided as elective opportunities at Johns Hopkins Hospital or Bayview Medical Center. Clinical Facilities The training program is conducted at Johns Hopkins Hospital and Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center. These hospitals have a diverse patient population, allowing for exposure to a wide range of allergies and clinical immunology problems. Each hospital has a unique character and attracts referrals for the treatment and evaluation of a wide range of allergic and immunological processes of the disease. Experience in various hospitals and outpatient clinics complements each other well, and doctors have unique clinical strengths, and patient care in each facility has a special emphasis, as described below. The presence of more than 70 different specialized training programmes in these institutions also supports the overall learning environment. Each of the hospitals has an active outpatient allergy/immunology service, and each hospital trains Hopkins medical students and home officers. Both hospitals sponsor weekly interdisciplinary conferences that address clinical issues. There is a program throughout the conference where clinical fellows present their most interesting cases for discussion and a weekly research conference where teachers present scientific related to asthma and allergic diseases. Googlers have been taking a number of trips to the Middle East, including one to Iraq last fall, to see how they can help speed up technology and Internet adoption in the area. That's where YouTube comes in. In the YouTube channel, sponsored by Coke featuring popular Pakistani musicians called Coke Studio, became so popular locally that it became the 11th most viewed channel on the site. And, Grove says, in a country whose television broadcasts were banned by non-state channels until eight years ago, news organizations are using YouTube to reach both Pakistanis at home and those living abroad. Boyd on Twitter. With a population of at least 50 million people, the Pashto people are the largest ethnic group in Afghanistan and the second largest ethnic group in Pakistan. They are also known as Pathans. Pashtunov is united by Pashtun, who is a member of the Indo-Iranian language family, although many also speak Dari (Persian) or Urdu. One important aspect of traditional Pashtun culture is the Pashtunwali or Patrol Code, which sets out standards of individual and community behaviour. This code may date back to at least the second century BC, although it has undoubtedly undergone changes over the past two thousand years. Some of Pashtunwali's principles include hospitality, justice, courage, loyalty and honoring women. Interestingly, Pashtuns don't have the myth of origin. Because DNA evidence shows that Central Asia was one of the first places where people left Africa, Pashtun ancestors may have been in the area for an incredibly long time - so long that they don't even tell stories about coming from another place. The history of Hindu origin, Rigveda, which was created as early as 1700 BC, mentions people named Covenants who lived on what is now Afghanistan. It seems likely that the ancestors of the Pashtuns have been in the area for at least 4,000 years then, and probably much longer. Many scientists believe that Pashtuns come from several ancestral groups. The population was probably of East Iranian origin and brought with it the Indo-European language to the east. They probably mingled with other people, including perhaps Kushans, Hephthalites or white Huns, Arabs, great moguls and others who passed through the region. In particular, Pashtuns in the Kandahar area have a tradition that they originated from the Greek-Macedonian troops of Alexander the Great, who invaded the area in 330 BC. Important Pashtun rulers included the Lodi dynasty, which ruled Afghanistan and northern India during the Delhi Sultanate (1206-1526 BC). The Lodi Dynasty (from 1451 to 1526 AD) was the finale of the five sultanates of Delhi and was defeated by Babur the Great, which founded the Mughal Empire. Up until the end of the nineteenth century AD, outsiders usually simply called Pashtuns Afghans. However, since the people of Afghanistan took their modern form, the word has been applied to the citizens of that country, regardless of their ethnic origin. The Pashtuns of Afghanistan and Pakistan should be distinguished from other people in Afghanistan, such as ethnic Tajiks, Uzbeks and Hazaras. Most Pashtuns today are Sunni Muslims, although a small minority are Shiites. As a result, some aspects of Pashtunwali appear to derive from Muslim law, which was introduced long after the code was first drafted. For example, one of the important concepts of Pashtunwali is the worship of one god, Allah. After the partition of India in 1947, some Pashtuns called for the creation of a Pashtun, carved from the Pashtun areas of Pakistan and Afghanistan. Although this idea remains alive among hard-line Pashtun nationalists, it seems unlikely to come to fruition. Famous Pashtun people in history include the Ghaznavids, the Lodi family who ruled the fifth iteration of Delhi's Sultanate, former Afghan President Hamid Karzai, and 2014 Nobel Peace Prize laureate Malala Yousafzai.
